How Much Do You Owe

Check back frequently – FALL Billing is currently a work in progress as the various items update and process.

To view account details and history:

Log into MyJudson
Then click on Student Info
Then click on Student Finances
Then click on Student Accounts
Click on My Account Balances
View Account Details & History

This updates daily as items are added

To view online statement:

Log into MyJudson
Then click on Student Info
Then click on Student Finances
Then click on Student Accounts
Then click on Go to Cash Net
Then click on Statements
Click on the statement you want to view

How Are You Paying?

FALL payments are due August 1. Spring payments are due January 1.

Please Note: All accounts that are not current may incur a \$150 late payment fee, have holds on them that will prevent students from making changes to their schedules, may delay moving into dorms, seeing grades, participating in activities and potentially from registering for future classes.

How To make an online payment:

- Chrome the preferred browser
- Log into MyJudson - Be sure to use Chrome
- Click on Student Info
- Click on Finances (left side of page)
- Click on Student Accounts
- Click on Go to CashNet
- Under Available Items, Click on Online Student Account Payment
- Enter the amount you are paying
- Click Pay Now
- Click Add to Payment
- Click Checkout (at bottom)
- Choose your payment method and continue
- Follow prompts

For Online Payments an additional 2.95% service fee for domestic card payments and 4.25% service fee on international card payments will be added. The minimum service fee for card payments will be \$3. Credit Cards Accepted: MASTERCARD and DISCOVER. Please Note: Due to restrictions imposed by VISA, we may not be able to accept VISA cards as a payment option.

There is an additional .50 fee if the electronic check method is used. You will need your bank's 9 digit routing number and checking or savings account number. Credit and debit card payments must be made online. We do not accept card payments in the office.

Be sure to include your Student ID on the check so that we can direct it to the correct account.

Need Help Paying the Balance Due?

Below are some financing options that may be available to you to help cover your outstanding balance due. All options do require applications and credit checks to be completed and support from a parent or other.

Apply for a Parent PLUS loan. Available to parents of dependent students. Approval requires passing a credit check. Parent PLUS loans are loans that the parent takes out for the student's benefit. The parent needs to use their FAFSA login when applying, as they are the borrower. If your parent is approved for the parent PLUS loan, they will also need to complete the online PLUS loan master promissory note.

Obtain a private loan. These loans may require a credit worthy co-signer and approval from the lender. Visit Elm Select at www.elmselect.com to view the many options for obtaining fixed or variable loans to cover tuition. Select Judson University for the school.

Obtain a loan from KCT Credit Union in Elgin, Illinois at <https://www.kctcu.org>. Their phone number is: 888-741-3344. Be sure to let them know you are a Judson student or parent of a Judson student who is interested in both a financial checkup and obtaining financing for the remaining student account balance.



Payment Plans Are Coming Soon

We are in the process of finalizing a new payment plan process. Information will be communicated as it becomes available.

Highlights of the new plans include:

- First payment and the \$100 payment plan fee will be due as part of the payment plan enrollment process.
- Fall payment plans will be 4 payments. First payment and \$100 fee due at enrollment in payment plan, second third and fourth payments due September 1, October 1 and November 1.
- Payment due reminders emailed to students enrolled in payment plans
